Q&A Questions & Answers about How to Give to the Called to Grow Campaign

Q Who do I make my check payable to?

A. To "Grace United Methodist Church"

Q. Where do I send/submit my check?

A. Either in the green Called to Grow envelopes in the pews or in the Welcome Center. You may also mail them to the church at 712 Church Street, Indiana, PA with "Attention: Diana Davis, financial secretary."

Q. Can I just drop my check in the offering plate? If so, how do I indicate it is for the Called to Grow campaign?

A. You can write "Called to Grow" on your envelope or use the green Called to Grow envelopes in the pew holders.

Q. Can I give my three-year commitment in one lump sum?

A. Absolutely!

Q. I have not yet made a commitment. How can I procure a commitment card and make my pledge?

A. Cards can be found in the Welcome Center or at the church office. They should be mailed to the church office or placed in a sealed envelope for the offering marked "Attention: Diana Davis, financial secretary."

Q. How can I make a change to my commitment level?

A. By completing a new card and sending it to the church office marked "Attention: Diana Davis, financial secretary."
