To ensure that your application for a Grace Higher Education scholarship is accepted for review, you must carefully follow the application instructions. In summary –

- ✓ Accurately complete all sections of the application
- ✓ Include a current transcript from your most recent institution of education
- ✓ Include a self-statement that reflects the three areas noted in the application
- ✓ Deliver the application and supporting documents in hard copy to the church office, or send all parts of the application via email as one pdf document
- ✓ The completed application and supporting documents must be received by the church office by May 28, 2025.

We want you to do the best job possible to ensure that your application presents an accurate representation of you to the review committee.

It is important that you do the best job possible on your self-statement. If you have submitted applications in previous years, it is strongly recommended that you **provide an updated self-statement**.

Applications that are incomplete will not be considered for a scholarship award.

Instructions

To submit an application to be considered for a Grace Higher Education Scholarship, provide each of the following –

1. The completed application form (both sides)
2. A completed Self-Statement (see reverse side of this application)
3. A copy of the current transcript from your most recent academic institution

All three parts of your application must be received by the church office by close of business on May 28, 2025. You must submit your application either in hard copy directly to the church office, or if you prefer to submit it via email, it must be packaged as one pdf document (contact the church office to obtain the correct email address for submission).

Be assured that this information will be used only for the purpose of scholarship evaluation. Your personal information will not be shared outside the evaluation committee.
